

e-Learning Program Verification Form

According to Section 10-20.56 of the School Code [105 ILCS 5/10-20.56], school districts may, by adopted resolution, utilize "e-learning days" in lieu of emergency days. The number of e-learning days may not exceed the number of emergency days in the approved school calendar. The district's e-learning program must be verified by the regional office of education or intermediate service center for the school district prior implementation. Classroom Connection Day School E-Learning/Distance/Home Learning Guidelines

CCDS will be utilizing e-learning, distance learning, or home learning days that will establish mechanisms to ensure substantial instruction or school work for each student participating in an e-learning day, distance learning, and other home learning opportunities.

- CCDS will ensure access from home for all students participating. Types of access include computers, the internet, and other forms of electronic communication (phone calls from staff, materials and individualized learning plans sent home to families, etc.)
- CCDS will ensure appropriate learning opportunities and supports are in place for students with special needs.
- CCDS will effectively communicate notice to all students and parents or guardians on the use of e-learning days.
- CCDS will provide staff and students on-going training for E-Learning/Distance/Home
 Learning participation, with particular attention paid to the ability of children to
 understand procedures and expectations.
- CCDS will review and revise the program as needed based on the results of implementation.
- Staff will be available for students during the hours of 8:45 am 2:00 pm
- Therapists will be available to provide services using unique opportunities (i.e. Skype, phone call, etc.)
